**Yield & Income Factors:** Base Moisture = 13.0% Shrink = 1.3 Drying = \$0.020 Prices = \$9.73 GMO; \$9.73 non-GMO

**TEST COMMENTS:** *At planting, wet soil conditions plus numerous post-planting rains, reduced stands in some varieties. The trial was heavily lodged, which made for a slow harvest. John commented about harvesting his lodged soybeans this year. The abundant August rains spurred tall soybean plants (50-60"). September and October rains helped lodge tall plants. Seed size was large and mostly good quality.*
